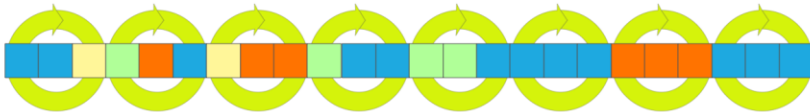




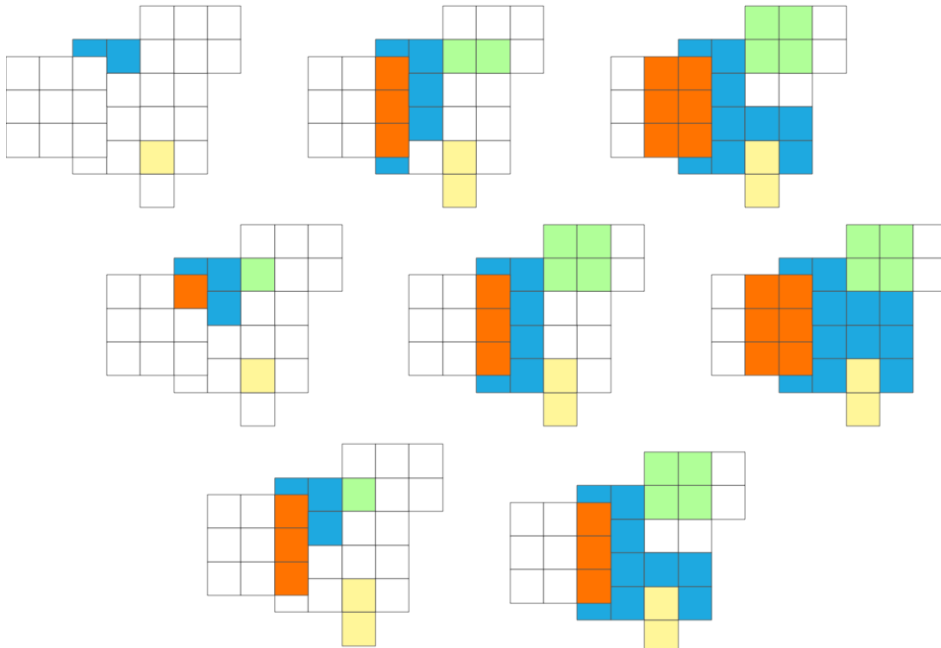
Big requirement chunks
of variable size



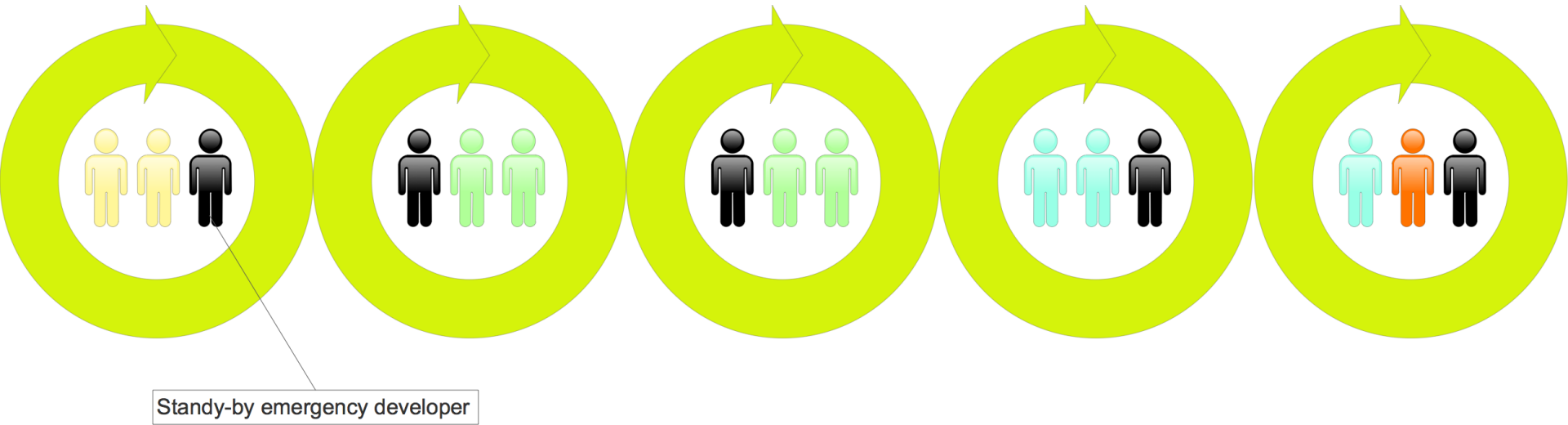
Finely sliced

size (≤ 1 day of work)

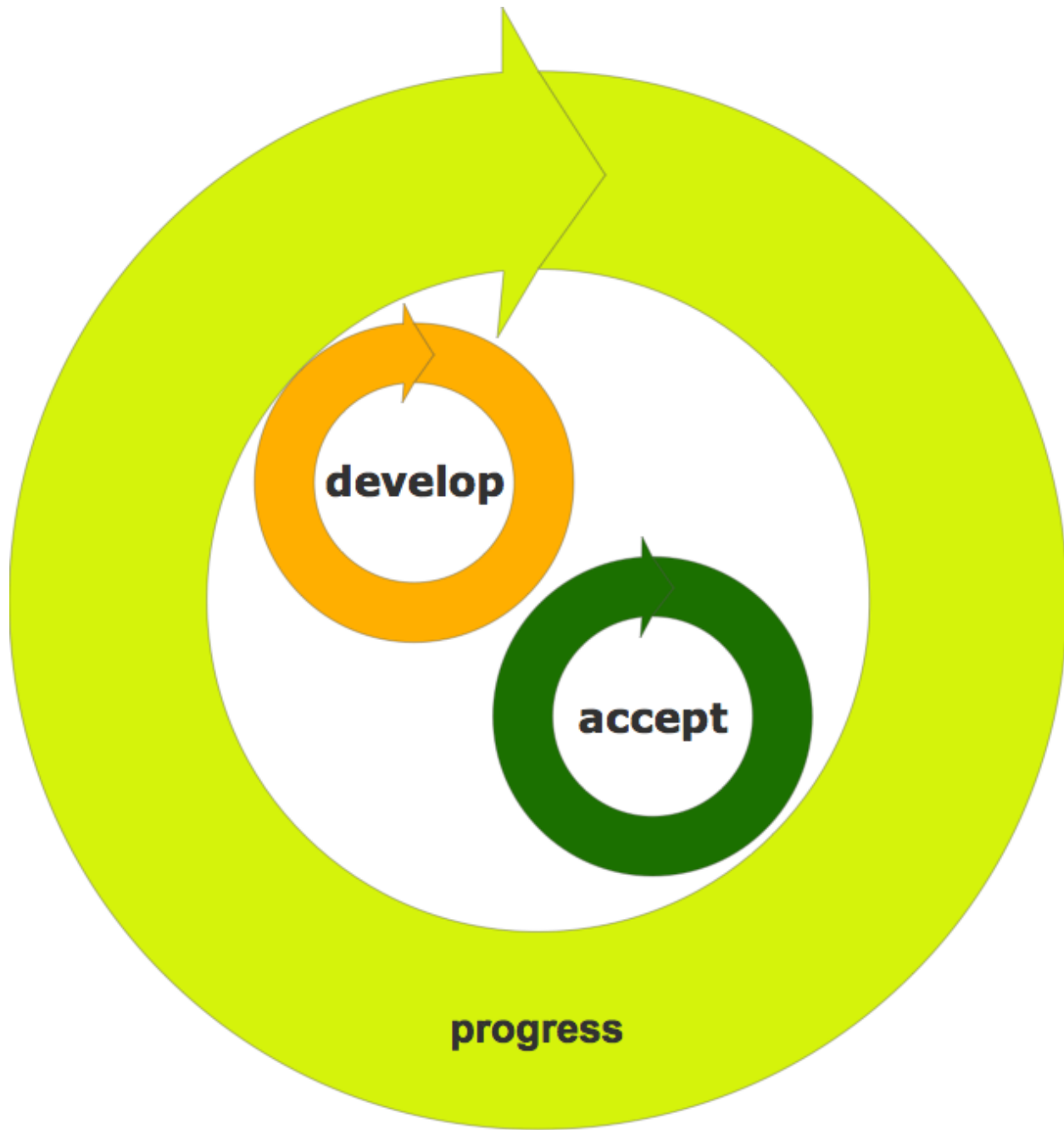


Working on requirement
